Santa Carolina Reserva Pinot – Chile

\$13.99

You will not find a better inexpensive Pinot Noir than this. There's so much going on here. Cherry, rhubarb, raspberries and more. The intensity of the aromas and flavours is what really gets your attention given the price. This is terrific stuff.

Cecchi Morellino di Scansano – Tuscany, Italy

\$20.99

From the coastal region of Tuscany, this is primarily Sangiovese. It's a bit more opulent in style than most Chianti is and there's quite a bit of dark berry fruit with hints of chocolate and coffee. It's a juicy, fresh style that makes it a great food wine. Pizza anyone?

Chateau La Branne – Bordeaux, France

\$26.99

Bordeaux can be sublime but the prices for really good Bordeaux are prohibitive. However, every now and then an incredible value like this wine from Medoc turns up. Wine Enthusiast raves that it's "a powerful and concentrated wine, rich and full of blackberry and black plum fruits. The structure will keep this fruitiness in order."

Raymond R Collection Sauvignon Blanc – California

\$20.99

One taste and you will know that this is definitely not New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc. The wine has great acidity and freshness but the fruit is riper and the flavours veer more towards tropical rather than citrus. There's also great texture to this wine and it's perfectly balanced. It's a great match for shellfish or fettucine alfredo.

Batasiolo Dolcetto – Piedmont, Italy

\$14.99

Dolcetto is a seriously underrated grape. It's an amazing food wine as it's bright fresh fruit and moderate tannins make it a great match for a wide variety of foods. This is a wine that positively explodes with flavour. There's lots of red berry fruit, along with notes of bittersweet chocolate. It's delicious and fun to drink.

Pasqua Passimento – Veneto, Italy

\$17.99

This is a Ripasso style of wine made from partially dried grapes. This is ripe and spicy, with notes of dried fruit and exotic spices. It's full bodied wine that's loaded with personality.

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
